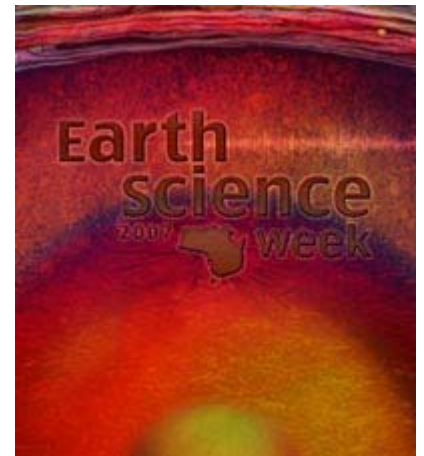


Taking the pulse of earth science

Earth Science Week is an international event which promotes awareness of and provides opportunity to celebrate the world of earth science. Earth Science Week 2007 runs from 14 to 20 October and is celebrating its tenth year with the theme 'The Pulse of Earth Science.'



This year's theme provides an opportunity for us to consider the state of the earth sciences, identify future challenges and develop programs and activities that will increase the profile of earth science in society. It is also an opportunity to incorporate themes from other international earth science celebrations such as the International Year of Planet Earth.

Geoscience Australia coordinates Earth Science Week activities in Australia by assisting with the sharing of earth science knowledge and resources between individuals, teachers, schools and organisations across the country.
